GCP is an international, ethical and scientific quality standard for the design, conduct, performance, monitoring, auditing, recording, analyses and reporting of clinical trials. It is a pre-requisite for anyone involved in new drug development or any kind of medical research. As per the guidelines of Indian council of medical research all investigators and staff involved in the conduct, oversight or management of any form of clinical research or clinical trials are required to complete training in GCP and refresh this training regularly to update the knowledge and concept, consistent with principles of the International Council on Harmonisation (ICH). This training should be updated once in every five years according to recent ICMR guidelines. This is even more pertinent given the many changes and amendments in the clinical trial and new drug approval rules and regulations in India in recent years. The course is suitable for individuals, both from industry and academia and all medical persons who are involved or interested in Clinical trial and new drug development in India. This includes investigators, regulatory affairs personnel, human ethics committee members, clinical trial team members/researchers.
